

God's Promises

When we give our lives to Christ and choose to have a relationship with Him, God gives us promises that we can trust in. It is important to know what these promises are and what they mean. These verses can help shed light on what you need to know

1. PROMISE OF FORGIVENESS

God wants to know us and forgive us. Once we give our lives to Christ and repent that forgiveness is unconditional. We don't need to be perfect in order to keep it, we just have to repent so that we can move forward instead of being stuck in the past.

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

2. PROMISE OF SALVATION

You are promised Salvation and that is not something that can be earned. God gives it to us and we just need to accept it. You don't need to spend your time worrying about whether or not you are good enough to deserve this.

1 John 5:11-12

And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.

3. PROMISE OF PRAYER

God wants to have a relationship with us and that means we need to interact with Him, like we would in any other relationship. God is always ready to be there for you and listen, you just need to connect with Him.

John 16:25

Proverbs 3:5-6

5. PROMISE OF VICTORY

Life can seem overwhelming and the things you are dealing with feel impossible, but they are not your forever. God promises to help us through even the worst things we go through. That doesn't mean our life is suddenly easy and perfect, but rather the difficult things in life can't hold you down like they used to. He wants to help you work through things.

1 Corinthians 10:13

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it
